Recruitment process

We are thrilled if you have found a position and would like to join our team! Here is what you can expect. Note that the entire recruitment process is handled by the hiring manager (your future leader) and HR.

1) Application

First, send in your application through our application portal. Due to the general data protection regulations (GDPR), we do not accept/review applications via e-mail. So, find the link to the open position you are interested in on <https://www.polytech.com/career/open-positions/>, and submit your application there.

We evaluate incoming applications on an ongoing basis, even if there is an application deadline. So, if you have found a position that you are interested in, there is no time to waste!

2) Confirmation

Once you submit your application, we will send you a receipt as confirmation and we will get back to you once we have read and evaluated your candidature.

3) Interviews

If successful in the first screening phase, we will invite you to an interview. Here we want to get to know you better, hear more about your skills, and understand how you would fit in our team.

You will be invited to minimum two rounds of interviews – but depending on the position, you might be called in for further interviews as well.

We conduct interviews both online (with camera) and in person at our locations.

4) Personality test

As part of the screening process, we will send you a personality test to assess your traits in relation to the expected work environment. Remember, there is no right or wrong answers here – these tests assess how well you would fit in your direct team and how well you would collaborate across departments and locations.

5) References

We will also ask you to provide some references from your previous workplaces (or from your studies, if you are a recent graduate). It is always a good idea to have 2-3 references on hand, and specifically references that can best highlight your skills for the position you are applying for at Polytech.

6) Job offer

Congratulations! This is where we call you and offer you the position – and cross our fingers that you liked us as much as we liked you!
